

# Sample Kindergarten schedule.

Children are provided with a balanced approach to learning that involves creativity, critical thinking, play, and hands-on exploration. The daily schedule allows time for both small group and individual work to reinforce and expand children’s reading and math skills as they emerge. Classroom teachers collaborate with the reading and math specialists to monitor development and implementation of curriculum as well as to monitor individual skill development.
